


According to data taken from the 02/01/21 PA Voter Rolls by Dr. Douglas G. Frank, almost 100 % of Chester County residents ages 70-100 are not only registered to vote, but voted in 2020. Captain Seth Keshel, a retired Army intelligence veteran and election data analyst, reported that Chester County received unusually high numbers of extra registrations and Democrat votes in the 2020 election. These numbers do not line up with historical trends of the county. In 2012 democrats gained 3,711 registrations, but had 13,522 less votes than the previous 2008 election. In 2016 dems gained 8,639 registrations, and had 17,371 more votes than the 2012 election. In 2020, dems had 20,388 added registrations (higher than normal) and had 40,690 more votes than 2016. Keshel suggests this could be due to phantom voters and phantom registrations. He conservatively estimates 19,000 phantom votes in Chester County.

According to Jeff O'Donnell, a software and database expert, Edison data on the night of the 2020 election shows the Chester County in-person and mail-in ballot vote totals appearing to be manipulated, with the incoming vote totals dropping down and then increasing again, over and over. See the short 90-second video above showing this. Vote totals are not supposed to go down. This begs the question, is Edison manipulating the vote totals? If not Edison, then who? O'Donnell also states that there was a point in the middle of the night on November 4, 2020 when one by one, the Edison data shows every state had their vote totals set to ZERO. The Chester County data was taken from the New York Times website, saved shortly after the election.

Backfilled Registrations

- There are registrations that are missing from the April 2020 voter rolls that have registration dates PRIOR to April 2020, which reappear on the voter rolls prior to the November 2020 election
 - The majority of these cases have registration dates years prior to the April export
 Some don't even appear until after the election with a 2020 vote on their record!
- 3332 of the total backfilled registrations go on to vote in the 2020 election
- There is a nearly equal distribution of backfilling for Republicans and Democrats in Chester County
 - 1478 Republicans, 1450 Democrats, 1018 Third Party
- These anomalies are not tied to any one precinct/city and are distributed throughout the county
- Age distribution for Chester County more closely resembles the age distribution of PA's voter data over Chester County's

During a presentation on October 13, 2021, Audit The Vote PA's data analyst, Vico Bertogli, reported the above Chester County 2020 anomalies. All the anomalies are important to consider, especially the one showing 47,345 people or 15% of all voters in Chester County's 2020 election were first-time voters. Also of note, 4,469 mail-in ballots were received AFTER the election

WHAT DOES ES&S SAY ABOUT THEIR MACHINES BEING INTERNET CAPABLE?

- > ES&S confirmed they had sold scanners with wireless modems to at least 11 states.
- While the <u>company's website states that "zero" of its voting tabulators are connected to the internet</u>, ES&S told NBC News 14,000 of their DS200 tabulators with online modems are currently in use around the country.
- ➤ "ES&S has repeatedly advertised its DS200 with internal modem a critical component to ES&S's voting systems as being EAC certified when, in fact, it is not," the letter said. "We therefore again respectfully request that EAC investigate and take action to correct this serious issue."
- ➤ The three largest voting manufacturing companies Election Systems &Software, Dominion Voting Systems and Hart InterCivic have acknowledged they all put modems in some of their tabulators and scanners. The reason? So that unofficial election results can more quickly be relayed to the public. Those modems connect to cell phone networks, which, in turn, are connected to the internet.

KEY FINDINGS OF ES&S DS 200 SCANNERS

Sourced from the <u>Antrim County, MI lawsuit (exhibit 6)</u>, <u>Patrick Colbeck</u>, and James Penrose, IV

- ➤ ES&S DS200 voting machines were found to have a <u>Telit LE910-SV1 Modem Chip</u> installed on its motherboard
 - Chip <u>utilized a commercial Verizon SIM card</u> with an Access Point Name (APN) configuration specific to the ES&S DS200 provisioning
 - > Chip allows for communication between voting system equipment and election servers
 - > Difficult to detect unless you pry open the machine case to investigate the hardware
 - The printed tapes that summarize the activity during the election show that the 4G modem was used to send the results to a central listener server via secure file transfer (SFTP).

ESS DS200 Machine

The DS200 machine was found to have a wireless 4G modem installed internally within the enclosure of the machine. The printed tapes that summarize the activity during the election show that the 4G modem was used to send the results to a central listener server via secure file transfer. The Telit LE910-SV1 in Figure 5 was found within the ES&S enclosure.



On July 14, 2022, Vico Bertogli also presented information from the DePerno Law website regarding ES&S DS200 machines and what was found when a DS200 was opened up in Antrim, Michigan. Chester County uses ES&S DS200s. Of importance to note, is the above modems connect to cell phone towers, which in turn, connect to the Internet. Simply looking to see if a voting machine is connected to a Wi-Fi network will not answer if it is connected to the Internet. You have to show it is not connected to a cell tower. 6. Were Chester County's voting machines electronically hacked?

Mike Lindell, best known as the CEO of My Pillow, claims that he was approached in January of 2021 with electronic recordings of the November 2020 election, showing the election was hacked and proving that Donald Trump won. Go to frankspeech.com to find many videos discussing the story and information. Information on who made the electronic recordings, the technology that was used to hack the 2020 election, and affidavits/declarations discussing the technology and covert backdoors into election machines can be found in this report on pages 13 and 14. Evidence is also presented on page 12 showing specifics of how machine software is manipulating votes. Lindell calls these recordings packet-captures, or "PCAPs." Due to a protective order that has been put over the technology used to record the election, only small pieces of the PCAPs have been able to be revealed publicly to help prove their validity. Lindell posted what he could on https://thebiglie.frankspeech.com/ PENNSYLVANIA/index.html. While we don't know the full story behind this posting below, we looked up the coordinates given for the hack(s) which targeted our Chester County Government Services Center in West Chester. The electronic manipulation total shows 26,156 votes were changed.



What We Know:

In the May 2022 Chester County Primary Election, video surveillance

footage from the Government Services Center dropbox shows 332 people putting multiple ballots into the dropbox in just two weeks. In total, 3,289 people dropped off 3,679 ballots. The law states that you must only return your own ballot. You are prohibited from delivering or returning anyone else's ballot, even if that person is your spouse, parent, child, grandparent, other relative, neighbor, or friend. If a voter has a disability or is voting by emergency absentee ballot, the voter may have someone deliver their ballot, only if both parties have signed an official written authorization. How many of these people did that? Whose ballots are they in possession of? If over 300 people put multiple ballots into one dropbox out of 13, how many ballots went into the drop boxes during the 2021 Municipal and 2020 Presidential Elections?







There is further information on 2020 dropbox trafficking in PA from the movie 2000 Mules. They claim that Philadelphia, PA had more than 1,100 "mules" (people) put multiple fraudulent mail-in ballots into drop boxes. Did this happen in Chester County? According to the description of the 2000 Mules website on the DuckDuckGo search engine, 2000 Mules is described as a documentary film created by Dinesh D'Souza, which exposes widespread, coordinated voter fraud in the 2020 election, sufficient to change the overall outcome. 

- * 150+ Voters who voted in 2020 but have no record of voting in PA registration system (SURE) (Right-to-Know response of Precinct Numbered-List-of-Voters compared to SURE voting history data)

CHESTER COUNTY CANVASSING UPDATE

- ➤ Audit The Vote PA's Chester County Canvassers visited 250 homes
 - ➤ We spoke with the voter and they completed our survey at 95 different addresses (38%)
 - ➤ There was some anomaly or issue with the response at 44 (45.23%) of the homes we visited
- ➤ On our survey, we ask "To the best of your ability, how many people were registered at this address for the 2020 election?" 86 people answered this question for us
 - > 32.56% of the responses did not match the actual number of registrations for their address at the time
 - > 24.4% of the responses showed extra registrations ("Phantom Registrations")
- ➤ On our survey, we ask "To the best of your ability, how many people voted from this address in the 2020 election?" 86 people also answered this question for us
 - > 23.26% of the responses did not match the actual number of votes at their address
 - ➤ 16.28% of the responses showed extra votes ("Phantom Votes")
 - ➤ 6.98% of the responses showed missing votes

Chester County Out of State Electors

- 13,680 registered electors moved out of PA and still are on the voter rolls
 - Moved between the Summer of 2017 and August 2022
 - 3,498 (25.5%) are still marked as active on our rolls
 - Active voters are still able to vote

Other registration address problems

- 2,678 electors registered in the wrong county. These voters vote for the wrong county and local candidates.
- 3,405 electors registered in the wrong city within the county. These voters vote for the wrong local candidates.

11. Chester County Problem: More Votes Than Voters

An underlying principle of a free and fair election is that the number of ballots cast cannot exceed the number of voters who participate in the election. Contrary to this basic tenet, the number of ballots cast exceeds the number of voters who participated in Chester County and most of Pennsylvania.

Pennsylvania Law on Reconciling Votes (Summary)

- Reconciliation of the number of voters with the number of ballots cast is required at every precinct polling place (25 PA § 3031.13 Post Election Procedures).
- Prior to certification, county elections boards are required to compare the number of voters who participated in the election to the number of ballots cast in every precinct.
- If there are more ballots than voters who participated in a precinct, the discrepancy must be investigated. No votes can be recorded from that precinct until the board completes the investigation. (25 PA § 3154 Computation of returns by county board; certification; issuance of certificates of election)

More votes than voters in Chester County *

- 2,609 in 2020 General Election (Source 11/30/2020 FVE)
- 631 in 2021Municipal Election (Source 11/22/2021 FVE)
- 496 in 2022 Primary Election (Source 06/02/2022 FVE)

In 2020, all 3 Chester County Commissioners certified the general election. In the 2021 Municipal election however, Republican commissioner Michelle Kichline voted NO to certification. Democrat commissioners Marian Moskowitz and Josh Maxwell voted to certify it, despite being warned by many residents before the vote that there were 631 more votes than voters and that it would be illegal to certify. In the 2022 primary, Republican commissioner Michelle Kichline issued a directive to Voter Services to investigate every discrepancy that occurred with reconciliation of the votes. These issues were later reported to her by Voter Services and what they did to remedy them. She felt that what was done was sufficient and voted to certify that election, along with Moskowitz and Maxwell.

2020 General Election

More Ballots Cast than Voters Who Participated

Each registered voter has the right to cast only a single ballot. To demonstrate a well-run election, a precinct must show that there are enough voters who voted to cover the number of ballots cast in that jurisdiction. For this analysis, the total number of voters who voted from the Full Voter Export (FVE) was compared to the total ballots cast, as reported by the county. Numerous discrepancies were found. The chart below (Table 1) shows ten counties that did not follow the law and did not reconcile the voters to the ballots cast.


B. Dr. Frank mentions that the registration databases are inflated. Are 87+ left leaning organizations inflating them? See this report by Verity Vote.



C. Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors (SURE) Problems

SURE is the statewide database of registered voters. Through SURE voters can be registered through a PA website, with a mailed application from numerous state offices, and by 87 third party (mostly left leaning) organizations which use direct computer-computer access. However by a PA Department of State directive, registrants are accepted absent validation, that is without valid PA DOT ID or valid last-4 Social Security numbers. (https://t.me/ChescoUnited/908).

PA uses a system called ERIC (Electronic Registration Information Center) to maintain its voter registration rolls, but ERIC mostly adds registrations and voters who move from the county are not adequately removed. See https://verityvote.us/eric-sharing-data-with-zuckerburg-funded-ngo/ and the "Chester County Out of State Electors" section of this report (above).



- ERIC elegible-but-unregistered additions exceed suggested removals by 10 times as shown in the graph to the left
- ERIC was founded by David Becker, previous director of the farleft: People for the American way.
- ERIC is cloaked in a veil of secrecy as its member agreement prevents disclosing information.
- ERIC shares data with the Zuckerberg funded Center for Election Innovation & Research (CEIR).
- CEIR creates lists of voters to be targeted for registration and launders these lists back through ERIC for distribution to states.

Validated Forensic Disk Images

The downloads are two forensic image files created from a Dominion voting machine. The two files are very large in size represent a *before* (EMSSERVER.E01 - 18.9 GB) and *after* (EMSSERVER_v2.E01 - 19.1 GB) of a single Dominon voting machine. Due to the large size of these files and depending on your Internet connection speed downloading these files may take anywhere from a few minutes to a few hours. The remainder of this article will detail what specifically is included in the download, how to use the downloaded files to perform your own analysis.

The Selection Code movie premiered in August of 2022. According to the Selection Code website (https://selectioncode.com), this movie "uncovers a secret so critical to the survival of America it transcends political parties." It follows the story of Tina Peters, the county clerk in Mesa, Colorado, who made a back up of her county's Dominion Voting System server, only to stumble across evidence of manipulation in a recent local city council election...and also the 2020 general election." This Power Point presentation by Software and Data Analyst Jeff O'Donnell is a summary of how the Dominion Voting Machines in Mesa County, Colorado manipulated ballots in their 2020 and 2021 elections. The information came from the forensic images that were made by clerk Tina Peters. O'Donnell explains how after voting already had begun and thousands of ballots were processed, the machine software then created new databases, reprocessed ballots and left thousands of ballots on the old database hidden, where no clerk could see them again. Since solid evidence exists that Mesa County Dominion machines were manipulating ballots, this leads to some questions. Did all Dominion machines do this? Are ES&S machines doing the same?

One recent piece of information regarding ES&S machines is that in Alabama it was discovered that their machines accepted a xeroxed copy of a mailin ballot during Logic and Accuracy testing. In Chester County, at the Chesco United May 8, 2022 event a man gave his testimony about how he was given a piece of copy paper as his ballot at the Coatesville High School during the 2020 election. He was told by the people manning the table at his precinct that "they were doing things differently this year." All Chester County Commissioners and Voter Services Director Karen Barsoum heard the testimony at a later date.

F. Hammer and Scorecard, and the covert back door into voting machines: Dr Navid Keshavarz-Nia Declaration

Attorney Kurt Olsen presented the following declaration from Dr. Navid Keshavarz-Nia at the Moment of Truth Summit on August 21, 2022. This declaration was filed in a lawsuit dated 11/25/2020. Dr Keshavarz-Nia states in the declaration that he is the chief cyber security engineer and subject matter expert for a large defense contractor. He also states that he has received advanced training from the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), National Security Agency (NSA), DHS (Department of Homeland Security) Office of Intelligence & Analysis (I&A), and Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

- 4. "The USIC has developed the Hammer and Scorecard tools, which were released by Wiki Leaks and independently confirmed by Lt Gen. Thomas McInerney (USAF, retired), Kirk Wiebe, former NSA official, and Dennis Montgomery, former CIA analyst. The Hammer and Scorecard capabilities are tradecrafts used by U.S. intelligence analysts to conduct MITM attacks on foreign voting systems, including the Dominion Voting System (DVS) Democracy Suite and Systems Software (ES&S) voting machines without leaving an electronic fingerprint. As such, these tools are used by nefarious operators to influence voting systems by covertly accessing DVS and altering the results in real-time and without leaving an electronic fingerprint. The DVS Democracy Suite Election Management System (EMS) consists of a set of applications that perform pre-voting activities."
- 6. "I have performed forensic analysis of electronic voting systems, including the DVS Democracy Suite, ES&S (acquired by DVS), Scytl/SOE Software, and the Smartmatic Systems used in hundreds of precincts in key battleground states. I have previously discovered major exploitable vulnerabilities in DVS and ES&S that permit a nefarious operator to perform sensitive functions via its built-in covert backdoor. The backdoor enables an operator to access to perform system updates and testing via the Internet without detection. However, it can also be used to conduct illicit activities such as shifting votes, deleting votes, or adding votes in real-time (Source: DVS Democracy Suite EMS Manual, version 5.11.CO::7, P. 43). These events can take place through the Internet and without leaving a trace."

After going over the above declaration, Kurt Olson then shared that Dr. Navid Keshavarz-Nia retracted his declaration comments on the 2020 election the following day. The reason why he retracted his comments are not known. Olsen pointed out however, that Keshavarz-Nia did not retract any of the statements regarding Hammer and Scorecard or any of the information on the voting machine systems and their covert backdoor. G. Dennis Montgomery: Technology developer who recorded the 2020 Election hacking

According to information given by attorney Kurt Olsen from the Moment of Truth Summit: Dennis Montgomery a computer scientist and software/hardware developer, submitted his personal declaration signed 8/19/22 which is now in a lawsuit dated 8/20/2022. It revealed that <u>he designed and developed</u> <u>the technology that is currently being used to electronically tamper with U.S. elections</u>. - **9.** "In 2002, eTreppid was approached by representatives of the United States Department of Defense (DOD) and Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), who expressed an interest in various surveillance Technologies eTreppid had been developing..."
- 13. "Beginning in 2005, I became aware that the CIA and the National Security Agency (NSA) had started using the eTreppid technology that I had developed for locating terrorists abroad to conduct surveillance of the United States..."
- 21. "When I learned of CIA and NSA's domestic surveillance using the technology I developed, I filed whistleblower complaints with the Inspectors General of the CIA, Department of Defense (DOD), Department of Justice (DOJ), Air Force, Director of National Intelligence (DNI), Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), and others. In those complaints, I objected to the misuse of this surveillance technology to monitor the private communications, bank records, attorney client communications, voting information and other private activities of American citizens."

Seized documents and electronic media reflected voting machines manufactures vulnerabilities to hacking. Voting machine manufactures communications and intellectual property we(re) hijacked by us gov numerous times over the years I worked in FBI/CIA/NSA surveillance programs, foreign and domestic."
- **40.** "In the recent 2020 elections, terabytes of data ("Election Data") comprising internet transmissions set during 2020 election were collected by the same technology I developed and previously licensed by the us gov. US GOV or their agents continued to use the "election technology" I licensed to them previously..."
